

In 2019, we began construction on Canada's largest building-integrated rooftop solar photovoltaic installation. In 2020, the centre will begin producing its own clean, renewable energy.

Our rooftops gardens and permaculture help to absorb heat, offset the urban heat island effect and reduce carbon emissions through cooling. The plants in our atrium **offset more than 4,000** of CO2 every year.





In 2019, 45% of our culinary team's purchases were made through partnerships with local producers and growers, reinvesting \$750,000 back into our local economy.



61% of our ongoing consumables are green certified or environmentally preferred products. 73% of housekeeping chemicals used are eco-certified, environmentally preferred products.
